Participants will have the opportunity to work with discipline- and college-specific facilitators to reinvigorate one course (redesigned syllabus, fresh attention to content, and at least one redeveloped assignment and rubric).

The course redesign will draw on critical pedagogies that attend to anti-racist and anti-imperialist demands for justice. This workshop will be limited to a small group of faculty with priority for faculty who are planning to teach their redesigned course in the upcoming academic year.

Participants must commit to the weekly meetings as well as commit to an additional hour or two of reading and hands-on course design work outside of the weekly meetings.
